

Department of Economics Minor Plan of Study

Preliminary or Final

An approved Final Minor Plan of Study must be signed by the Economics Undergraduate Advisor and filed with the Registrar's Office during the first four weeks of the semester in which you expect to graduate.

Requirements for a Minor in Economics:

- C (2.0) or better in each of the required courses
- Pre-requisite courses:
 - ECON 1201 & ECON 1202 (or ECON 1200), Principles of Micro & Macroeconomics
 - MATH 1071Q or 1131Q, Calculus
 - STAT 1000Q or 1100Q is required for *some* upper-level ECON courses
- ECON 2201, Intermediate Microeconomics Theory
- ECON 2202, Intermediate Macroeconomics Theory
- At least one course in the ECON 2300 series or 3000 level or above
- Two additional 2000 level or higher ECON courses
 - Note: ECON 2481 and 3481 do *not* count towards the minor requirements
- Maximum of 3 credits toward the minor may be transfer credits of a course equivalent to University courses.
- Total of 15 upper-level credits
